### Costs

Indicative costs to students attending the event are **upwards of \$2,000 per head** which includes the following costs.

- DUSA Payment:** **\$650** (for 5-day events) includes twin share accommodation, selected meals, insurance, off-field uniform. This is the rate available to DUSA Gold Members. An additional \$200 is due for non DUSA Gold members.
- UniSport Payment:** **\$225-275** UniSport Australia Registration (sport event costs). This rate varies dependent on the length of your event and how early you register.
- Uniform:** **\$100** Deakin Dragon playing uniform cost.
- Travel costs:** All travel is arranged and paid by the student.
- Extras:** All incidentals and meals (outside of those provided by DUSA) is at the students' expense.

### More Event Information:

UniSport Nationals events provide students with a great opportunity to represent their university while connecting with fellow student athletes. High-level competition is tied in with an amazing atmosphere. We encourage you to have a good look through the [event website](#) including the event schedule.

### How do I get selected for the team?

- Step 1.** Fill out a competitor info form via the above links. This is your chance to list in detail your competitive history in your sport. Team Managers will receive this information, and it will help with selection, so include as much detail as possible.
- Step 2.** Attend a trial if you are applying for a team sport. This is your chance to meet the Team Manager and/or Coach and show your ability. If you are applying to an individual sport, the information in your competitor info form will be used for selection.
- Step 3.** Team Managers/Coaches will select a training squad and begin training sessions.
- Step 4.** Teams will be selected by the Team Manager/Coach by the 30<sup>th</sup> of June. Individual competitors will also be notified by DUSA of their selection at this time.
- Step 5.** You will now register for the event with DUSA by the 17<sup>th</sup> of July.

**PLEASE NOTE:** If you are interested in joining a team after the trial dates, please go ahead and fill in the competitor info form regardless. The Team Managers will receive your application and may choose to invite you to come along to a practice session.

**Due Dates/Timeline:**

- 30<sup>th</sup> June: By this date, the final selection of players for the team will be made.
- 17<sup>th</sup> July: Due date for DUSA Payment and registration. Students will not be able to register for the team after this date.
- 17<sup>th</sup> July: Begin registering for the event with UniSport using your team code.
- 10<sup>th</sup> August: Standard UniSport registration closes.
- 21<sup>st</sup> September: All UniSport registrations close.

**I need more time to find the registration fee!**

If you don't have the DUSA registration fee by the closing date, buy now pay later options are available at checkout.

Unfortunately, DUSA can't provide financial assistance, and because of uniform and UniSport team deadlines, the due dates are not flexible.

**Team Manager Communication**

Deakin Dragon teams are managed by Deakin students. Once you are confirmed in the team, they will set up a group chat so the team can communicate before the event. Stack Team App will be used by DUSA to communicate to the team at the event.

**Uniforms**

Uniform kits are collected by students from their Team Manager in the week before travelling to the event.

**Transport**

All students are to arrange their own transport to and from the event as well as while in Perth. The teams can communicate to arrange ride shares, car hire, public transport, etc.

**Academic Extension Requests**

The event takes place in the Trimester 2 study period. If you need to apply to your Unit Chair for any extensions, a letter of participation will be provided by DUSA. You can present the letter of participation to your Unit Chair. Extensions are at the Unit Chair's discretion.
