Key Responsibilities

Content Creation

- Attend and film at DUSA events (Student Engagement and Club led) and capture authentic moments that highlight the student experience.
- Interact with staff DUSA Club members to understand the essence and messaging of the content you will create.
- Create a content schedule and develop your own creative ideas to boost awareness of each DUSA department (including membership, events, clubs, sport, advocacy, financial wellbeing, short courses, trips and student representation)
- Create fun, engaging, on-trend video content quickly and consistently through compelling storytelling for various social media platforms
- Create content of 'everyday student life' at Deakin the little, funny or quirky things that are unique to Deakin student life

- Post edited content on DUSA social media platforms ensuring that brand guidelines are followed.
- Write captions, select music, add effects and ensure brand consistency in all posts

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- Attend on-campus events to capture real-time content

- Collaborate and liaise with all DUSA departments
- Monitor content performance and stay ahead of social media trends.
